The parent/legal guardian signing this form releases Big Stone Camp for Christ and all of Big Stone Camp for Christ personnel from any liability for such decisions or actions in seeking medical care, and agrees to pay all the costs and fees for the medical care or treatment authorized under this Emergency Medical Authorization.

The parent/legal guardian agrees to hold harmless Big Stone Camp for Christ and the owners of any properties BSCC made available for camp activities, from any claims, damages, losses and/or expenses arising out of participation in camp activities and to assume all liability for any and all personal injury, bodily injury, illness or property damage that occurs as a result of participation in such camp activities. The parent/legal guardian also warrants that participation in this camp is voluntary and that the camper and the parent/legal guardian understand the inherent risks involved in camp activities and the camper agrees to obey all rules and policies mandated by camp personnel.

CODE OF CONDUCT

For Campers at Big Stone Camp for Christ

Statement of Purpose

Our goal for each child attending a summer camp program is to have an experience of Christian community in which the camper is safe and grows spiritually and socially. Because of this goal, campers are encouraged to participate in all camp activities to the best of their ability. Likewise, campers are encouraged to treat one another and the staff with mutual respect. During a week in camp, in the course of activities, it is natural that there will be conflicts within cabin groups and between campers and their counselors. It is resolving these conflicts – in the give and take of negotiation – that some of the most important lessons of a week at camp are learned.

Occasionally, however, behavior on the part of a camper may become as disruptive as to require his/her removal from camp because conflicts cannot be resolved. Therefore, the following guidelines are presented for children during their week at camp. Parents are encouraged to review these guidelines with their children.

1. Abide by the rules and regulations of the camp.
2. Use language appropriate for the Christian community.
3. Respect the rights, privacy and property of others.
4. Respect the property and facilities of the camp.
5. Wear appropriate clothes for activities as suggested by camp staff.
6. Engaging in or threatening acts of physical, sexual or verbal abuse is prohibited (camper/camper or camper/staff).
7. Possession or use of tobacco, e-cigarettes, alcohol, or any illegal substance or paraphernalia is prohibited.
8. Possession or use of weapons is prohibited.
9. Possession of cell phones or other electronics is prohibited. When a camper is caught with cell phone or other electronics, parents will be called immediately to come get the device.
10. Campers out of cabins past curfew without counselor's permission may be sent home.

Disciplinary Action

Big Stone Camp for Christ will attempt to be fair on assessing consequences for camper behavior. When appropriate consequences shall be given in a progressive order in relation to the severity and/or frequency of the infraction(s). The specific disciplinary action and severity of punishment for inappropriate camper behavior will be handled by the Camp Director and/or the Board of Directors. Law enforcement officials will be involved when laws have been broken. Parent/guardians and campers will be made aware of their rights under the law.

Zero Tolerance Policy

Because we want campers to be able to experience the safest week possible, Big Stone Camp for Christ has adopted a zero tolerance for the following behaviors.

1. Possession or use of tobacco, alcohol, e-cigarettes, or any illegal substance or paraphernalia.
2. Possession or use of weapons of any kind.
3. Theft.

4. Physical assault or threats of harm to self or others.
5. Sexual violence.

Any camper who willfully violates any of the above rules will be dismissed immediately.

Search of Personal Belongings

In order to provide for the safety of campers and staff, Big Stone Camp for Christ retains the right to search all personal belongings of every camper who attends camp-sponsored events. If any staff member has reasonable suspicion that a camper possesses any substance, article or weapon that is in violation of the code of conduct, the Executive and/or Program Director(s) have the right to perform a search of the camper and the camper's belongings. If a camper refuses to be searched, Big Stone Camp for Christ will treat the incident as if the camper were found to be in possession of a substance, article or weapon in violation of the rules of conduct and the camper will be dismissed. If a search is performed, the Program Director(s) will determine the appropriate time and place and will have the camper present during the search.

Reimbursement of Fees

If a camper is dismissed due to inappropriate behavior, no refund of camper fees will be available.

Admission Agreement

Likewise, I am aware that my child is expected to abide by all regulations governing personal conduct and use of camp property. If my child does not cooperate, or becomes a hindrance to the camp program, I understand that my child will be sent home.

WHAT WE'RE ABOUT

Big Stone Camp for Christ is a Christ-centered Camp. We want our focus to be on Jesus, and how we can learn more about Him and live for Him. To accomplish this, we want to stress these things: **MODEST DRESS** and **CLEAN LANGUAGE. NO ELECTRONIC DEVICES (INCLUDING MP3 PLAYERS, HANDHELD GAMES, ETC), CELL PHONES. IPADS, IPODS OR RADIOS.** Campers are expected to be at all activities and may only be excused with permission of the Camp Director or Camp Pastor. If your camper has an appointment during their week, please fill out the enclosed time commitment sheet so we can plan accordingly. One other thing we need to address: Big Stone Camp for Christ reserves the right to call the parents of any camper that continually disrupts chapel, other worship, or meal times and have them come get their child at their expense. We want Camp to be a fun, learning experience for everyone.

CAMP FEES:

Sr. and Jr High weeks - \$155.00 if registration and fee are postmarked before May 1. After May 1, it will be \$180.

Primary week - \$120 if registration and fee are postmarked before May 1, \$145 after May 1.

Registration fees and canteen money must be included with the registration. All forms – registration, code of conduct, time commitment and medication instructions - must have signatures and be filled out completely and sent with your registration.

If you have questions, the camp email is bscfc2018@gmail.com and we will get back to you as soon as we can.

With the high cost of postage, and the amount of materials we send out, much of our communication is now by email. If you have an email address that is used often (even if it is the camper's), **PLEASE** include it on your registration. You can include both a parent's email and the camper's email. This is the fastest, most reliable way to receive information about Camp.

REMINDER:

1. Snacks from home – Campers will no longer be allowed to bring snacks from home. For one thing, they attract pests to the cabins – ants, flies and mice like those goodies just as much as the kids do. We also don't want any temptation for others to help themselves. ***If your child has special dietary needs and cannot purchase snacks at canteen, please let us know. Their food will be kept in the kitchen and given to them at canteen time.***
2. Code of Conduct – Included with your registration will be a Code of Conduct. **All campers and their parents will be asked to sign and return this document with camper registration.** Anyone not signing the Code of Conduct will not be allowed to attend Camp.
3. Since campers in the past have not been forthcoming about turning in their cell phones and other electronics, parents will be called immediately to come get the phone at the time it is discovered.

LOST AND FOUND

All items left at Camp will be held for two weeks after Primary Camp, then donated to a thrift store. Big Stone Camp for Christ is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
